CALL TO ORDER

DIRECTOR GRAZIANO

Director Graziano called meeting to order. Motion to begin meeting made by Director Blankenship, motion seconded by Director Garcia. Approved by the board, Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MEETING AGENDA

BOARD

Director Graziano called for a motion for the agenda to be approved. Director Blankenship made a motion to approve meeting agenda, and Director Garcia seconded. Motion carried by all the board.

REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

BOARD

Board members reviewed June's meeting minutes. Minutes were approved. Motion was made by Director Blankenship and seconded by Director Garcia. Meeting minutes for June were signed and filed with the county by Director Garcia.

YTD FINANCIALS: Director Blankenship, Treasurer/ Dave & Debbie Stanford

Dave Stanford read aloud July's financial reports. Year-to-Date: Gross \$119,524.37, Total Expenses \$59,084.72, Total Net Operating Income \$60,439.65. July Gross Profit \$29,351.24, Total Expenses \$7,195.56, Net Income \$22,155.68.

Director Blankenship made a motion to move \$35,000 to Colorado Trust. Director Garcia seconded. Motion carried.

Review and Approval of Bills

Director Tisler/Debbie Stanford

Invoices of July's bills were discussed with the board and a motion to approve checks was made by Director Garcia and seconded by Director Blankenship. Motion carried.

Review of disconnected accounts.

Owner of account 5 was present. Debbie has been sending the water bills to both the address of the owner as well as the residence. Owner claims that she has not received any of the bills and does not want to pay the late fees. Director Blankenship asked what amount she was willing to pay at this time. She was willing to pay the entire amount for water usage but not any late fees or attorney fees. Director Blankenship made a motion that the amount of \$1,924.24 for water

usage be paid in full tonight, August 10, 2021, and if the check bounces, all fees will be added to the amount owed. Director Garcia seconded and the motion carried. If this happens again, everything will be sent to the owner by certified mail. Even if she doesn't sign for it, it will still be her responsibility to respond and to take care of the bill. The owner agreed. Director Blankenship made a resolution that the name on the bill always stays in the primary owner's name unless they change it. Director Garcia seconded. Debbie will send a check to cover Peter's fees.

Account 113 is owned by the bank. The last payment was from April 6,2020. We will post a sign that money is owed for water bill and water will not be turned on until paid. Account 142 paid \$487.94. Accounts 145 and 164 will need to be posted. Account 177 has a payment plan.

Director Graziano requested that we raise the Director's pay to \$75. Dave suggested we raise it to \$100. He will budget it in to the new budget.

OLD BUSINESS: BOARD

We need to build the new sign on Clifford. Director Blankenship reported that the new sign cannot be concreted because of regulations. He will bring a design to next meeting.

The water treatment plant is operating normally, and the wells & pressure pumping system are working flawlessly. The water pressure pumps, and the wells continue working based on water levels in the water storage tank.

WATER PLANT:

The water treatment plant is working well. The OPTO 22 automation system is working well.

METER READINGS:

We continue to aggressively approach meter repair and meter transmitter replacement.

Water sales for the July billing are equal to last year.

The July 2021 sales comparison to July 2020 to the right shows the water sales. The red line represents 2021 water sales.

PAST DUE ACCOUNTS:

The aged balance report has

been sent to the board prior to the meeting. Account # 5 is an ongoing problem. Peter has submitted a board resolution and a letter addressing Account # 5. At this point the account meets all the legal requirements for collection using a property tax assessment.

2021 WATER SAMPLING:

The required water sampling for 2021 as outlined in the CDPHE monitoring schedule will be completed in August. A review of the 2021 Monitoring Schedule shows the following required sampling: Nitrate, Nitrite, TTHM'S, HAA5, and Lead & Copper from five homes.

2021 PLANED IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS:

Again, the storm water pond remediation will likely begin at the end of September. The contractor, Parker Excavation, is booked until then.

DISTRICT WEB SITE & PUBLIC NOTIFICATION SYSTEM:

UBMax is offering a web page service. Perhaps it is time to move forward with a district webpage. One would hope this will make things just a touch easier for the water users.

DISTRICT BUDGET OFFICIAL:

As Logan has moved, and it's August, it is time for the board to appoint the 2022 budget official. As always, I will assist the board appointed budget official in getting the 2022 budget completed and through the regulatory process.
